Knitted fabrics made with raw yarns [Cotton, Viscose (including Bamboo and Ecovero®), Modal (including Micromodal), Lyocell (including Lenzing™ and Lenzing™ A100/Wool), Cupro, Flax, Polyester, Polyamide (including Breeze), Wool, Cashmere, Hemp, and Cotton/PVA], mélange yarns [Cotton, Viscose (including Bamboo), Modal, Lyocell (including Lenzing™) and Polyester], dyed yarns [Cotton, Viscose (including Bamboo and Ecovero®), Modal (including Micromodal), Lyocell (including Lenzing™ and Lenzing™ A100/Wool), Flax, Polyester, Polyamide, Acrylic and Wool], their blends including with metallic and metallized yarns in Polyester and Polyamide and with Elastane bare or covered with Polyester or Polyamide.  
Dyed and finished knitted fabrics in Cotton, Viscose (including Bamboo and Ecovero®), Modal (including Micromodal), Lyocell (including Lenzing™ and Lenzing™ A100), Cupro, Flax, Polyester, Polyamide, Wool, Cashmere, their blends including with metallic and metallized in Polyester and Polyamide and with Elastane bare or covered with Polyester or Polyamide and with Elastane covered with raw and dyed yarns in recycled Polyamide (Q-Nova®, <20%, pre-consumer) and recycled Polyester (<20%, post-consumer from PET bottles).  
(Based on starting materials already STANDARD 100 pre-certified).

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class II** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for products with direct contact to skin.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
